This fabulous bear hunt and the first hunt that my boys and I have been on together could not have happened without all their help!

When I found out that I had been selected to go on a free bear hunt with my boys I was very excited. I couldn't wait to get to the hunting ranch and be a part of the outdoors with my boys.

When we got there, I was blown away!

When I think of a hunting cabin; I think of a small one or two room cabin with no amenities other than a fire place. I couldn't have been more wrong. The owner of the ranch where we were hunting had a beautiful guest house and was letting us stay in it. They even cooked our meals for us. I was totally blown away that so much was given to us for this hunt.

Everyone we came in contact with was so friendly and helpful; they treated us like kings! I have to admit this trip spoiled me for future hunts.

We arrived on a beautiful snowy day. After we got settled in there was a little daylight left so we drove around to several spots on the ranch looking for bears. We did not find any bears that evening but saw lots of beautiful scenery.

The next day we piled into the vehicle and began what is and will be for a while the greatest hunt of my life. After going through the cold morning and only seeing one momma bear that had a cub with her, we came back for lunch.

After lunch we decided to go back to a spot we had checked a couple of times before.

As we walked down the two-track road looking into a beautiful valley my guide spotted her; grazing on grass in this cut out in the valley was my bear. A gorgeous chocolate colored bear.

After a little trial an error we found a spot where I could shoot through the trees. I lay in a prone position and the second I saw her in the scope "bear fever" hit me like a freight train!

2014 Big Game Hunting

It is hard to believe that it is already time to start scheduling 2014 big game hunts for Handi-Buddies who have sent in their 2014 Big Game Hunt Requests.

If you are a Handi-Buddy and want to have a chance to be placed on an Outdoor Buddies sponsored big game hunt, please send in your 2014 Big Game Hunt Request as soon as possible! You can use the form included with this newsletter or you can submit your hunt requests via the Outdoor Buddies website at:

Those of you wanting to help take Handi-Buddies out on their hunts please contact me.

I want to take a moment to remind you all of some of our basic rules about participating in Outdoor Buddies sponsored big game hunts.

To hunt big game with Outdoor Buddies you have to have an "Accommodation Permit" issued by Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) authorizing you to shoot from a vehicle. This permit also authorizes your able-bodied helper to track and dispatch wounded animals.

Handi-Buddies must submit a Big Game Hunt Request.

Every Handi-Buddy who sends in a hunt request will be designated as a number 1, 2 or 3.

Number "1" is a Handi-Buddy who was not selected for an Outdoor Buddies hunt for a deer or elk in the previous year.

Number "2" is a Handi-Buddy who was selected for an Outdoor Buddies big game hunt the previous year, but did not harvest an animal or couldn't make it on the hunt because of a cancelation due to medical reasons.

Number "3" is a Handi-Buddy who participated in an Outdoor Buddies big game hunt the previous year and filled their license for either an elk or deer.

By designating Handi-Buddies as a 1, 2, or 3 we can place Handi-Buddies in a fair way on the limited Outdoor Buddies hunt slots. We first place all of the number "1" in the hunt slots.

We then place the number "2" in the remaining hunt slots. Then if there are still hunt slots left we start to place the number "3" Handi-Buddies until we run out of hunt slots or hunter requests.

Our mission is to get everyone out who has been deprived of the outdoor experience.

We are not a hunting club where the same hunters go to the same location every year.

We try to place Handi-Buddies on at least one big game hunt each year, but all of our hunts are on donated private land and the demand is sometimes greater than the number of available hunt slots. Outdoor Buddies is always searching for more hunting opportunities.

These are a few of our rules and procedures that we use to place Handi-Buddies in a fair way to give everyone a chance to go on a great outdoor experience!

MOBILITY-DISABLED HUNTING PROGRAM
2014 BIG GAME HUNT REQUEST**

REQUIREMENTS/CONDITIONS

1. Participants in Outdoor Buddies sponsored big game hunts must be registered members of Outdoor Buddies. Registration must have been completed prior to being considered for a big game hunt.
2. All Colorado hunters must possess a "WILDLIFE RECREATION ACCOMMODATION PERMIT", issued by Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW), authorizing the hunter to shoot from a vehicle. It is also suggested that hunters be enrolled in CPW's Mobility-Impaired Big Game Program; for questions and application form contact CPW at (303) 291-7380.
3. Participants are expected to provide **their own transportation to/from and during the hunt**, unless other arrangements are made in advance, and pay personal expenses including required licenses. Outdoor Buddies will provide a location to hunt and an able-bodied helper/guide.
4. To request a hunt complete the lower portion of this form and mail to **Outdoor Buddies, 555 Highlands Road, Westcliffe, CO 81252**.
Hunt requests may also be submitted online via Outdoor Buddies' website at www.outdoorbuddies.org.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Outdoor Buddies Big Game Hunt Committee will review all requests received and work with hunt applicants determine eligibility, plan, and schedule the hunts. Please inform Larry Sanford at (970) 663-7852 if you have not been contacted by the Committee within thirty days after you have submitted a Big Game Hunt Request.

HUNT LOCATIONS

Applicants may designate an area where he/she would prefer to hunt, however it may not be possible to schedule that location due to the limited number of opportunities at each hunt location. Shown below is a list of some of the locations where Outdoor Buddies will sponsor big game hunts in the upcoming seasons.
